

Every London resident can now apply to get £2,000 to scrap their car

The Mayor of London's scrappage scheme has been expanded so that every London resident can now apply.

So, if you're one of the few who has a vehicle that doesn't meet the ULEZ standards, you can now get £2,000 to scrap a car or £1,000 to scrap a motorcycle. Alternatively, you can receive up to £1,600 plus one or two TfL Annual Bus and Tram passes.

Wheelchair accessible vehicle owners can get up to £10,000 (previously £5,000) to scrap or retrofit their vehicle to the ULEZ standards.

Further ULEZ support offers are also available, such as discounts on car clubs and bike hires.

9 out of 10 cars seen driving in outer London on an average day meet the ULEZ standards, so their drivers will not need to pay the charge. But if yours doesn't, apply now.
